Booth and Fee: \$250 fee for a 10x10 space. Vendors may purchase a double booth if needed. Please indicate on application if electricity is needed.

PROCESSING TIME: Please allow at least 6 weeks to process your application from the date it is received. Please always try to apply as early as possible to make for a smooth process

WAITING LIST: Once shows are closed, applications are still accepted for the waitlist. We will contact you as early as possible IF any spaces become available. Please keep in mind that this may be as late as 2-3 days before the show. If you cannot work on short notice, the waitlist may not be the best option for you. - 5. Booths are to be kept in professional appearance. Please try to keep the area behind the tent tidy and covered if possible.
- 6. All artists must comply with parking locations; vehicles will be towed!
- 7. Check in: There will be designated areas for check in where artists will receive booth assignments, parking passes and directions for where to park. Lunch menus will also be provided as well as review of general information.
- 8. Setup will be on Friday, May 26th between 9AM-5PM. All booths must be set up before 9:30 AM on Saturday (27th) and Sunday (28th).
- 9. Loading and unloading needs to be done as quickly as possible.
- 10. If electricity is needed, we **must** be informed on your application.
