

Before submitting your application

Please note that the 2022 Hilton Head Art Festival at Shelter Cove Harbour & Marina (Hosted by Nash Gallery) is a fine art and fine craft show and not all submissions will be accepted. Previous admissions to festivals in the area will not serve as a guarantee to a spot in this show, nor will any artist retain a location from an earlier show. We require artists to submit new applications even if they have participated in shows before. Space is limited compared to previous years due to location change.

Application deadlines are April 20th, 2022; however, artists will be informed in a timely manner whether or not they have been selected so they can plan accordingly. Although the deadline is April 20th, spaces may fill up before that time and we will close/extend submissions at our discretion. We will keep artists on a waitlist in the event that spots become available as well.

If you have any requests please specify on your application or speak with us directly. We will do our best to accommodate any requests within reason.

General Information

2022 Hilton Head Art Festival is hosted by Nash Gallery, and is produced by Shelter Cove Merchants Association and Palmetto Dunes Resort.

The mission of the Hilton Head Island Art Festival is to encourage, promote, and support the arts in our community.

The Hilton Head Island Art Festival will take place on Saturday, May 28th and Sunday, May 29th.

Application Deadline: April 20th , 2022

Show Hours: Saturday 10AM – 6PM, Sunday 10AM – 4PM

Booth and Fee: \$175 fee for a 10x10 space

- Artists provide tents and displays, the tent must be **WHITE**
- Exhibitors are **not** to begin packing or otherwise dismantling their displays before 6 PM SAT and 4pm SUN.
- Your booth must be designed to withstand wind and inclement weather (**40lb weight MINIMUM** on each leg of booth), this is a **RAIN OR SHINE EVENT!**

Security

24-hour security will be provided by the festival; however, we are not responsible for loss or damage.

Parking

Reserved parking will be provided for each exhibitor. License plate number, make and model of vehicle are required. Artist passes will need to be in the front window of vehicle. Cars parked outside of their provided area will be towed.

Sales

Artists retain all revenue from the sale of their work and are responsible to accept payment from customers.

Load-in: Staggered load in and out; be patient!

Lunch: Hilton Head Social Bakery will provide a box lunch to be delivered between 12PM-1PM for those who wish to partake. Fee will be \$5-\$10 depending on your choice of several options.

Rules of Hilton Head Island Art Festival

1. All work must be original, handcrafted work. Artists guarantee the accuracy of the description of works presented and the authenticity of work as the creation of their own hands.
2. No more than two artists may collaborate on work. Both must be included and sign the application.
3. Artists must be present with their work for both days of the festival.
4. All work exhibited must be of the quality, category, and body of work shown in person or by digital.
5. Booths are to be kept in professional appearance. Please try to keep the area behind the tent tidy and covered if possible.
6. All artists must comply with parking locations; vehicles will be towed!
7. Check in: There will be designated areas for check in where artists will receive booth assignments, parking passes and directions for where to park. Lunch menus will also be provided as well as review of general information.
8. Setup will be on Friday, May 27th between 9AM-5PM. All booths must be set up before 9:30 AM on Saturday (28th) and Sunday (29th).
9. Loading and unloading needs to be done as quickly as possible.
10. If electricity is needed, we **must** be informed on your application.
